

# WEATHER CONDITIONS ADVISEMENT

Update: 10-23-18

**WARNING:** Please be warned that significant rain is expected Wednesday which could create a large rise in the Llano River again. If we get 1 inch of rain the river could rise to 15 ft from 5 ft now. 2 inches of rain it could rise to 25 ft and 3 inches of rain to 35 ft. Last Tuesday the river rose to near 40 ft. The county will deploy assets in advance of any pending flood. Please be aware of potential flooding again and stay safe.

## Update:

- In conversations with TXDOT they are moving quickly to complete plans to rebuild the 2900 bridge across the Llano River with construction expected to start by December. In view of this, no ferry is planned since the construction of boarding platforms will slow down the construction of the bridge. This is the same reason to not construct a temporary Bailey Bridge. The Slab Road at CR307 has been inspected by TXDOT and is in good condition but the road will remain closed until the river subsides.
- A Multi Agency Resource Center is set up at the JFJ Event Center in Llano and is open until 8 pm tonight Oct 23<sup>rd</sup>. It will relocate to the Kingsland Community Center for Oct 24 & 25<sup>th</sup>. This is a place to get information and help from various county and state departments.
- A Volunteer Reception Center (VRC) has been established at the First Baptist Church in Kingsland and will be open Monday to Saturday 8 am to 4 pm and Sunday 1 pm to 4 pm. The VRC will register volunteers who offer to help and deploy them where needed. Those in need can also register for help they may need to match with volunteers.
- Debris removal is still in the planning stage to contract with a firm(s) to pick up debris at curbside. Impacted owners can place debris in piles at the curbside. The piles should be separated as best as possible into various categories as shown on the attached flyer. You will be advised when debris will be collected.
- If you have boats or jet skis that floated into your property you can check ownership and contact information of the owner at the Parks and Wildlife Department website at <https://tpwd.texas.gov> under the boat registration tab and enter the boat registration number to have the owner remove it.
- Free tetanus shots are being offered at the Seaton Clinic in Llano due to possible infection from handling debris.
