**UPDATE FOR PRECINCT 1,
Including City of Sunrise Beach Village**

In Precinct 1 clean-up has started in the City of Sunrise Beach that experienced significant damage on the waterfront from the flood. The Debris Removal Firm that the County contracted with started the clean-up November 26th and will continue until curbside debris is removed. Initially this is a slow process due to the trucks having to drive to the closest disposal site in Hutto to unload, a 4 ½ hour round trip. This is being corrected by having the debris transferred from the trucks to large debris trailers that will dispose of the debris in Hutto. The process is also impeded by narrow streets and overhead wires that do not allow the large trucks to get access. Smaller equipment will be brought in to deal with this.

The schedule for Precinct 1 is not yet fully determined by date but I have requested that the hardest hit areas nearest to the collapsed 2900 bridge take priority. This is where most of the debris in Precinct 1 is located.

Each community has identified a contact person to help coordinate the clean-up in their community and will be contacted when the clean-up for them is scheduled.
